

GREENWOOD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING  
JULY 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2022

Chairman Roy Ballard called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Ben Fox, Paul Hodge, Robert Morgan, Chuck Spradlin, County Counselor Paul Dean and Deputy County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

*Fox moved to approve July 5, 2022 Minutes, as written. Morgan seconded. Motion carried 5-0.*

Road and Bridge Report:

- Culverts that were approved for purchase last week are slated to be delivered at the first of next month.
- The culvert replacement on 300<sup>th</sup> Road is still on schedule to be completed Monday, July 18.
- Crews are working on rock ledges in the northern part of the county.
- Crews are doing patch-work on Reece Road while they wait for the original contractor to make contact with Darrel regarding their return to Greenwood County to make necessary repairs to said road.
- Chrisman provided an update on the Christian Hills Bridge project.
- Shoulders on Ranch Road need mowed and drainage issues need addressed.

Fall River area residents June Bailey, Tina Kastning and Della Lind shared safety concerns of road conditions of 37<sup>th</sup> Street around the 2200 block. Bailey inquired as to whether the roads in question were the responsibility of the county or the township. Darrel is slated to look into the matter. Salt Springs Township Trustee Jeff Pittman also voiced concerns regarding the roads in question. Bailey then inquired about township funding; it was noted that the townships set their own taxes/mill levy and budget. A brief discussion was held regarding where the responsibility lies pertaining to approaches to bridges; If it is a minor issue, the township should make the repairs, for a larger matter, the county should be contacted. Pittman referenced a couple of low water bridges in need of debris removal.

*Morgan moved to approve payables in the amount \$441,126.42. Spradlin seconded. Motion carried 5-0.*

*Fox moved to approve payroll in the amount of \$128,547.98. Morgan seconded. Motion carried 5-0.*

*Fox moved to adjourn at 9:35 a.m. Morgan seconded. Motion carried 5-0.*
